SUBJECT: Equal Opportunity (EO) and Non-Discrimination Policy

- 1. The policy of the 434<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing is not to condone or tolerate unlawful discrimination or sexual harassment, of any kind. Additionally, at no time should any reprisal action be taken against a member or employee who reports or participates in an investigation of a possible violation of this policy. Once unlawful discrimination, sexual harassment, or reprisal is alleged, immediate and appropriate action will be taken to investigate/resolve the allegations and ensure any proven unlawful behavior stops.
- 2. Unlawful discrimination is the unfair treatment of any Airman or civilian on the basis of race, color, religion, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), and national origin. In the case of civilian employees, additional basis include age (over 40), disability, genetic information and reprisal. Sexual harassment involves unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors or other verbal or physical contact of a sexual nature. Additional guidance can be found in AFI 36-2706.
- 3. Persons who are aware of any violations or believe they are victims of discrimination or sexual harassment are urged to report it immediately through their chain of command or to the Grissom EO office located in building 596 room 233, at 688-3421/2408. The civilian EO representative, Ms. Diana O'Brien can be reached at 688-2557.

- 1: **Must** be a military member, family members or retirees. For Civilians, must be an AF employees, former employees or applicant for employment who meet the criteria outlined in 29 CFR Part 1614.

Two types of complaints: formal & informal.
